

- 1) In order to be eligible for this funding you must be a member of the Sussex Minor Basketball Association, Sussex Middle School or Sussex High School programs.
- 2) In order to be eligible for this funding you must attend the 2019 DTC Summer Camp or provide a reason why you were not able to attend. Your bursary amount may be reduced by the cost of the DTC Camp if you are not in attendance at the DTC Camp.
- 3) The DTC Committee will award a bursary for the <u>tryout fee</u> of all local basketball players for Basketball New Brunswick Programs.
- 3) The DTC Committee will award a bursary of \$125 to those who make the BNB week long **Bantam (U14) Elite** Summer Camp and are staying on campus; \$75 if staying off campus and \$100 if staying off campus but taking advantage of the meal plan.
- 4) The DTC Committee will award a bursary of \$400 to each local player that makes the BNB (**U15**) Competitive Team.
- 5) The DTC Committee will award a bursary of \$400 to each local player that makes the BNB **(U17)** Competitive Team.
- 6) The DTC Committee will award a bursary of \$30 \$55 to each local player participates in the BNB Elite Development program. Fee is \$140.00 (spring) \$240.00 (Full Year) for Jr EDP, and \$150 for Sr EDP.
- 7) The DTC Committee will award a bursary of \$15 to each local player who makes the U14 team to participate in the Summer Fest in Saint John. Fee is \$60.
- 8) The DTC Committee will award a bursary of \$250 to each local player who makes the new Provincial Team Program (PTP). Fee is \$1,200.
- 9) The DTC Committee will award a bursary of \$115 to each player of the local program who attends a week long, on campus, University Basketball Camp during the summer. Those staying off campus will receive approximately one half of this amount.
- 10) The DTC Committee <u>may</u> award a bursary for Elite programs other than Basketball New Brunswick programs. Please attach details of the program you are applying for.
- 11) The DTC Committee will award a bursary up to \$200 for all **basketball coaches and referees**, in the Sussex programs, to allow them to attend clinics, seminars, pay for the medical for their drivers license and other related activities that they are not being compensated for, to enhance their coaching and referee knowledge.

All tryout fees are separate from the team and/or camp fees. Items <u>not</u> covered under Bursaries are Sussex Hoop Camp, Sussex Team Camp and Club Teams.

All Bursaries must be applied for on the proper application form available from the Bursary and Scholarship Chairperson – Sarah Hicks or at Source for Sports and at **Dairy Town Classic and Sussex Minor Basketball Association websites** and will be emailed to those on the email list. <u>Deadline for applications is May 31, 2019</u>. The maximum Bursary amount any player may receive each summer is \$400.00.
